You need a **library card**.

Borrowing something means:

You can take a book home for a while.

You have to return the book afterwards.

How do you get a library card?



You get the library card at the Library of Esch.

You register at the Library of Esch.

You have to bring one of these papers for your **registration**:

- Your identity card. This is the "carte d'identité".
- Or your passport
- Or your residence permit.

This is a paper from the Immigration Office.

This means that you have permission to live in the country.

Digital means: you can read or listen to books
on a tablet or a computer.

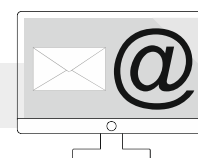
What are your duties?

- You agree that your info is used.

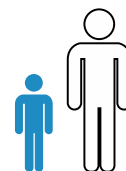
